Full Membership

Full members must be engaged in economic development and must be an individual. Groups can qualify under the "Organization" category.

Associate Membership

An Associate member must be an individual

Qualify
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Municipal, provincial or federal government ➤ Private Business / Private Consultant / Contractor ➤ Public Bank or Financial Institution ➤ Agencies & organizations ➤ Associations like <i>Alberta Chamber of Commerce</i> unless it complies with full membership criteria ➤ Friendship Centres

Student Membership

To be eligible to become a Student member, an individual must be enrolled in one of the following fields of study: **Business Administration/Economics, Business Finance, Business Management, Natural Resources, and/or Community Economic Development.**

Note: If one is a student as well as practicing EDO, he/she can have an option of taking a **Full Membership** instead of a **Student** membership, and consequently have voting rights.

Conversely: If a Student member would like to run for the CANDO Student Board position, he/she must provide proof in the form of a student card issued by their educational institution stating that they are enrolled in one of the qualified fields of study.
