He has also worked as Product Manager for the Cree Native Arts and Crafts Association, an important economic development agency within the Cree Nation of Eeyou Istchee (Cree Nation Territory). His work involves contributing to the growth of a sustainable arts, crafts and cultural economy in Eeyou Istchee involving partnership among Cree artists, artisans and Cree communities.

Throughout his career he has maintained a keen interest in photography which he expresses through a local enterprise, Bosum Media & Photography. He specializes in videography, photographing special events including weddings, school portraits and special events.

He also serves his community as an informal Music Production Studio Advisor by guiding local youth who have expressed an interest in music. He assists in liaising with professionals in the industry and providing planning and other support services.

Harry Bosum has successfully completed courses in Project Management (Algonquin College), Graphic designer and small business Entrepreneurial Development.

In addition to his services in the area of economic development, he contributes to the development of his community in other ways also.
